ITINERARY

Members from divisions 1, 2, and 3 will all compete for the Northern Artisans Competitions. All played over 36 holes, medal from the White Tees.

Those who prefer and qualify can elect to enter the Seniors division, which will be a 36-hole stableford completion from the Yellow Tees.

Minimum age to qualify to be 60 years on or before the Monday of the start of the Tournament.

The only person to be able to win two trophies will be the Scratch Champion.

Could all Secretaries please provide the Congu National ID numbers for any Competitors who did not play in last year's tournament.

The entrance fee includes all daily sweeps and 2's club for both days and a hole in one prize. Which will roll over each round, should this not be won then the whole fund will be donated to our chosen charity, the Children's Air Ambulance.

Value of Sweeps, 2's and hole in one fund will depend on numbers. Sweeps will be 1st 2nd & 3rd in each division daily on back 9 count backs with no ties.

Courtesy of the Course is available on the Sunday prior to the Competition, tee-times are from 2-32 to 5-28 pm play in 4-balls allowed, and can be booked through Wallasey Golf Club. (0151 691 1024)

The cost for the above mentioned is all included in your entry fee of £75...00 which represents excellent value for money.

THE DRAW

Competitors must start in the correct order and at the times specified, otherwise they will be liable to disqualification.

Players are requested to be on the first tee in good time and make themselves acquainted with the LOCAL RULES.

Should any player fail to hear their name called at the scheduled time they should enquire at once to the Official Starter. Handicaps will be shown on the score cards. Which will be obtained from the Front Desk. These should be applied for in good time.

CONDITIONS

The conditions governing the Tournament shall be as in previous years, and the Executive Committee of the Artisans Golfers Association (Northern Section) shall constitute the Committee. They reserve the right to alter the Handicap of any player or players.

And in all matters their decision is final.

As seems likely that the Tournament will be over sub-scribed, therefore, after the Clubs who have been regular supporters of the Tournament over previous years, have been allocated their normal quota of Entries, a ballot will determine as to who is allocated a space in the Tournament. Providing of course there are vacancies readily available.

As we may experience late withdrawals and cancellations, we may have to make alterations to some of the tee-times, in order to utilize all of the tee-times that are available to us. The Committee have therefore requested that all entries be accompanied with a mobile telephone number. (See Entrance Form.)

No Buggies are allowed unless you have a current Medical Certificate, which must be produced to the Officials on the days of the Tournament. Only persons covered by the Certificate may ride on the Buggy.

INACTIVE HANDICAPS ARE NOT PERMITTED.

COMPULSORY MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

A two-course meal has been organised for all competitors with multiple choice from the menu. Meals should be taken as follows :-

CATERING

All entrance fees and correspondence should be returned to the Tournament Secretary by the closing date of **Friday 24th April 2020.**

The number of entries for each Club will be confirmed by **Thursday 30th April,** to the E-MAIL address provided on the entry form.

The draw and times of play will be E-mailed to the address provided and will be available on NAGA Master score board site by the **14th June 2020.**
