The 90th Northern Artisans' Annual Tournament Information

The following competitions will be played for as indicated with full handicap allowance, the only exception being the Scratch Championship Trophy.

Northern Championship Trophy 36- hole lowest scratch score

1st Division

Northern Artisans J H Taylor Challenge Trophy 36-hole medal. Sir Lindsey Parkinson Rose Bowl 36- hole Medal.

2nd Division

Northern Artisans J H Taylor Victory Trophy 36-hole medal W J Gardener Cup 36- hole Medal.

3rd Division

Frank Brookhouse Memorial Trophy 36-hole medal Harry Jackson Trophy 36- hole medal

Seniors Division

Harry Hood Shield 36-hole Stableford yellow Tees Jack Powel Trophy 36- hole Stableford yellow Tees

Team Shield Trophy

Team of three, selection from divisions 1, 2, and 3 only. Top 2 scores to count. Only 2 teams of three from each Club are allowed.

ITINERARY

Members from divisions 1, 2, and 3 will all compete for the Northern Artisans Competitions. All played over thirty-six holes, medal from the White Tees.

Those who prefer and qualify can elect to enter the Seniors division, which will be a 36-hole Stapleford competition from the Yellow Tees. Minimum age to qualify to be 60 years on or before the Monday of the start of the Tournament.

The only person to be able to win two trophies will be the Scratch Champion.

The entrance fee includes all daily sweeps and two's club for both days and a hole in one prize. Which will roll over each round,

Value of Sweeps, twos, and hole in one fund will depend on numbers. Sweeps will be 1st 2nd & 3rd in each division daily on back nine count backs with no ties.

THE DRAW

Competitors must start in the correct order and at the times specified, otherwise they will be liable to disqualification.

Players are requested to be on the first tee in suitable time and make themselves acquainted with the LOCAL RULES.

Should any player fail to hear their name called at the scheduled time they should enquire at once to the Official Starter. Handicaps will be shown on the score cards. Which will be obtained from the Front Desk. These should be applied for in suitable time.

CONDITIONS

The conditions governing the Tournament shall be as in previous years, and the Executive Committee of the Artisans Golfers Association (Northern Section) shall constitute the Committee. They reserve the right to alter the Handicap of any player or players.

Inactive handicaps are not permitted. And in all matters their decision is final.

No Buggies are allowed unless you have a current Medical Certificate, which must be produced to the Officials on the days of the Tournament. Only persons covered by the Certificate may ride on the Buggy.

COMPULSORY MEAL ARRANGEMENTS

A two-course meal has been organised for all competitors with multiple choice from the menu. Meal Vouchers for each day will be issued to each competitor. Meals should be taken as follows :-

<u>Monday</u> First half of the field <u>Tuesday</u> Second half of the field

CATERING

Food is always readily available for anyone at the Clubhouse , at their own expense. Full English breakfast or Sandwiches will be available for early starters, and through-out the day.

All entrance fees and correspondence should be returned to the Tournament Secretary by the closing date of <u>Friday 9th May 2025.</u>

The number of entries for each Club will be confirmed by <u>Friday 16th May 2025</u>, to the E-MAIL address provided on the entry form.

The draw and times of play will be posted on the <u>Masterscore Board</u> <u>Northern AGA Page</u> by <u>Thursday 12^{1h} June 2025</u>. If you require an Email copy of the draw and times of play, then please Email Paul Blagg the Competition Secretary, who will then return a copy to you directly.
